Solid Rock Youth Ministry Covenant

Definition:

A covenant is a solemn oath made before God to create and enter into a new relationship. Unlike a legal contract, a covenant is a statement of faith in the One who unites us, and in the love, which binds us, and a promise to uphold the integrity of the relationship for the sake of all parties.

Scriptural Basis:

"Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility regard others as better than yourselves. Let each of you look not to your own interests, but to the interests of others. Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus..."

(Philippians 2:3-5)

Solid Rock Youth Ministry Covenant:

Through our unity in Christ we acknowledge each other's gifts and contributions to the group. We are all dependent upon one another to maintain an atmosphere in which love and spiritual growth can take place. Every member of Solid Rock is expected to behave in a manner that is consistent with the values and teachings of our faith. We will show our respect and love for one another by following the rules below.

- I will attend and participate fully in the entire event, unless otherwise agreed upon with the youth leader(s).
- I will arrive on time, stay till the end, and remain at the event location at all times.
- I will respect the event premises at all times. I understand that vandalism, disturbing the peace or inappropriate behavior as determined by the youth leader will not be tolerated. I understand that I will have to pay for any damages that I cause.
- I will not smoke or consume or distribute **DRUGS, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, or TOBACCO** products of any kind during a Solid Rock event. In addition, I will not remain in the presence of individuals who are using or asking these prohibited items. Drug paraphernalia is also considered inappropriate.
- I will dress and speak in a manner that is respectful and courteous to all members. Cursing and gossip are not acceptable.
- In an overnight event, I will abide by the event curfew announced by the youth leader(s). I will go directly to my sleeping area and stay there until the following morning. I will also be respectful of those that are around us, including surrounding rooms, and those in the group that may already be sleeping.
- I agree that public displays of affection and sexual contact are inappropriate at Solid Rock events and will not be tolerated.
- I agree to stay with the group at any off site event, unless small groups are permitted to break away. In the event that small groups are allowed, I **PROMISE** to stay in that small group at all times, and a youth leader(s) will know my approximate location. I will be punctual when returning to the large group.
- I agree that all personal items brought to Solid Rock are my responsibility. Any lost, stolen, or broken items are not the responsibility of the youth leader(s).
- I acknowledge that all rules outlined in this Covenant and by the youth leader(s) for that event will be respected and followed even in the small groups.

I understand that by breaking one or more of these rules during a Solid Rock event I'm not only disrespecting the group and the youth leader(s), I'm disrespecting myself, my family, and my church. In this event I realize that my parents will be notified. I know that I can be excused from an event if the advisors feel it is necessary; in this event my parents will be called to make arrangements or transportation home at the expense of my family.
